Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (Big Tree Track) **Habitat**: Closed wet Eucalypt forest. **Substrate**: Moss on mossy log (parallel to BTT) **Description**: Gregarious to clustered stalked ellipsoid sporangia, 3.2 mm tall x 0.6 mm diameter on brown hypothallus. **Sporotheca** ellipsoid, with iridescent peridium that breaks off in flakes 1.2 mm long. **Peridium** iridescent with blue, purple and golden reflections, slight darker and plicate at base. **Stipe** Black, 2 mm long, approximately ²/₃ height of sporangia. **Columella** almost reaching the top of sporotheca, tapering at

apex. Capillitium dense, at right angles to columella, brown near

columella, white and more branching at tips.

 ${\bf Spores.}$ Brown in mass, red brown by transmitted light with dark irregularly scattered warts 11–16 $\mu m.$

Notes: Several groups of this species currently in the field.
