Date 24 July 2018. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track). **Habitat**: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate on moss on fallen dead *Bedfordia salicina*.

Description Scattered and clustered sessile globose pale lemon to yellow sporangia 0.4–0.7 mm diameter. Sporotheca globose, pale lemon to yellow upper part impregnated with yellow alcium carbonate granules; lower part different from upper part, orange brown without granules and slightly plictate towards base Hypothallus inconspicuous Columella absent. Capillitium conspicuous, relatively large rounded or elongate yellow nodes connected by threads only visible by transmitted light. Spores dark brown in mass, dark by transmitted light, minutely spiny, 10 μm. Notes Bright yellow when it first appeared, then dark and inconspicuous; first record at Black Sugarloaf - and Tasmania.
