

**Date** 24 July 2018. Black Sugarloaf, Birrale (big tree track).

**Habitat:** Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

**Substrate** on moss on fallen dead *Bedfordia salicina*.

**Description** Scattered and clustered sessile globose pale lemon to yellow sporangia 0.4–0.7 mm diameter. **Sporotheca** globose, pale lemon to yellow upper part impregnated with yellow alcium carbonate granules; lower part different from upper part, orange brown without granules and slightly pliculate towards base **Hypothallus** inconspicuous **Columella** absent. **Capillitium** conspicuous, relatively large rounded or elongate yellow nodes connected by threads only visible by transmitted light. **Spores** dark brown in mass, dark by transmitted light, minutely spiny, 10 µm. **Notes** Bright yellow when it first appeared, then dark and inconspicuous; first record at Black Sugarloaf - and Tasmania.
